# *Copy 'n Press*<sup>TM</sup>

*Iron-On Transfer Paper for  
White or Light Color Fabrics  
For Use in Commercial Color Copiers*

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

### ● **COPYING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSOCIATE AT YOUR LOCAL COPY CENTER.**

1. Insert a single sheet of Copy 'n Press<sup>TM</sup> in copy machine at a time.
2. Copying should appear on the front, unmarked side of the sheet.
3. Have the copier "flip" or "mirror image" your photo or graphics, especially if it contains text.  
This assures that your transfer image will be correct when ironed onto project.

### ● **TRANSFER DESIGN TO 100% PRESHRUNK COTTON, 50/50 BLENDS OR 100% POLYESTER FABRIC.**

1. Trim blank, uncopied area around your image if desired.
2. Preheat iron to high "cotton" setting. **DO NOT USE STEAM.**
3. Iron fabric to remove moisture and wrinkles.
4. Position transfer as desired, printed image side **DOWN**, onto garment.
5. Press iron firmly over the transfer in a circular motion for 15 to 20 seconds in each position until the entire transfer has been completely covered.
6. Heat the entire surface of the transfer.
7. Remove the backing paper while hot for a satin finish or peel when cool for a glossy finish.

### ● **LAUNDERING**

(Transfers have a stiff feel to them when new. This feel will become softer after washing.)

1. Wait at least 72 hours after transferring image before laundering.
2. Turn garment inside out.
3. Wash in warm or cool water.
4. Use detergent only. Do not use bleach. Do not use fabric softener the first time laundering.
5. Remove from washer **IMMEDIATELY**.
6. Tumble dry on cool setting.
7. If wrinkled, do not iron directly on transfer. Cover image with a sheet of baking parchment or press cloth before ironing and allow to cool before removing.

## **IT IS EASY AND FUN TO USE!**

Copy 'n Press<sup>TM</sup> is a heat transfer paper designed for use in commercial color copiers such as some color toner copiers or thermal ribbon copiers. Do not use in copiers with a heating element. Not compatible with home copiers, inkjet printers or laser printers. This paper does not work in all copy machines and should be tested to determine the suitability of the paper for use in conjunction with your equipment and methods. June Tailor's and the manufacturer's maximum obligation shall be to replace any paper which has been proven to be defective.
