Iron-On Quilt Label Fabric Sheet Instructions

For use in computer color ink jet printers.

Design Your Quilt Label

- You may design your own quilt label on the computer.

OR

- Select from one of the 24 label designs available on our website.
- Go to www.junetailor.com. Click the "FAQ" Section or locate the "Quilt Label Sheet" page in the "Notions" section of our "Products". Click on the link to access the label design page.
- Click in the center of the label and type your message and quilt information. The typeface and color is pre-programmed for your convenience. Try using the space bar at the beginning of lines as well as the enter key of your keyboard to position words exactly as desired.

NOTE: Instant editing capabilities may not be available with all browsers or computer types (ie. tablets or phones).

If you are unable to type directly in the label . . .

- Right click on the label. A pop up window should appear with an option to "Save Page As". Click on this option and save the PDF to your computer. When you open the PDF, you will then be able to type your information by clicking in the center of the label.

If you wish to use your own fonts, sizes and colors:

- Open any word processing program such as MicrosoftWord* or WordPad*.
- Create your personalized message using your desired fonts, sizes and colors.
- Highlight and "copy" your text.
- Open the desired quilt label border per instructions above.
- Click on "Edit" from the menu bar, and click "Paste" from the drop down menu. If you do not have a menu bar, right click in the center of the label and click "Paste" in the pop up window. Your message will appear in the label as you had created it.

Print Your Quilt Label

- These labels will print within the top half of the 8 1/2" x 11" Quilt Label Fabric Sheet. Therefore, you can print one label, then turn the fabric sheet around to print a second label.
- You may wish to test your finished label by printing to a plain piece of paper first.
- Insert one Quilt Label Fabric Sheet into computer color ink jet printer so that printing appears on the fabric side of the sheet.
- Printer should be set at plain paper, normal quality. Select your printer from your "File" dropdown menu, as opposed to selecting the printer icon in your browser.
- Allow ink to dry for 30 minutes.
- Trim around label.

Iron Your Quilt Label

- Preheat iron medium/high to highest (cotton) setting. DO NOT USE STEAM. (Empty any water that may be in iron and preheat for five minutes).
- Place printed quilt label on back of quilt as desired, image face UP.
- Press for 10 to 15 seconds, making sure all edges of the label are thoroughly fused.

Laundering Instructions

- May be washed by hand in cold water. Use a small amount of liquid fabric softener in water if soiled. Do not use detergent. May be tumble dried on low setting or laid flat to dry.

This product is intended for use in standard ink jet printers only. Do not use in other printers or copiers such as laser printers or any other printer / copier that applies heat, as it may damage the machine. Test the product you plan to use to determine the suitability of the product for your equipment, methods and substrate material.
