Light T-Shirt Transfer Sheet Instructions

Light T-Shirt Transfer Sheets are a transparent base material to be used on white or very light color fabrics. Light T-Shirt Transfers have a single purple line printed on the back side of the sheet. Print "reverse" or "mirror image" from your computer color ink jet printer to create your own personalized wearable art.

Read instructions carefully prior to use.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- T-shirt, garment or other project on which to apply transfer. Works best with cotton and polyester/cotton blends. Do not wash or clean garment in any way prior to applying the transfer.
- Computer and color ink jet printer.
- Ordinary household hand iron.
- Pillowcase.
- Smooth, hard, heat resistant surface such as a wood cutting board for ironing. Do not use ironing board, glass or heat sensitive surfaces.

CREATE YOUR IMAGE:

- Design your image on a computer using photos, clip art and / or text. "Mirror Image" before you print. This may be referred to as "flip / horizontal" in your computer program's tools. Many printers offer "mirror image", "t-shirt" mode or "reverse" mode in their printer settings options.
- Test print your image on a plain piece of paper.
- Insert a single sheet of transfer paper into printer so that printing occurs on the plain, unmarked side of the transfer sheet.
- Set printer at normal quality, plain paper. Print image.
- Allow image to dry 30 minutes before transferring.
- Using a scissors or craft knife, trim out image to desired shape.

IRON APPLICATION:

- Pre-heat iron to high (cotton) setting. **DO NOT USE STEAM.** (Empty any water that may be in iron. Allow iron to preheat for five minutes).
- Place pillowcase on smooth, hard, heat resistant ironing surface such as a wood cutting board. Do not use ironing board. Iron pillowcase to remove wrinkles.
- Iron project to remove any moisture and wrinkles.
- Position transfer **FACE DOWN** on project surface.
- Iron over the entire transfer in a circular motion making sure that each spot of the transfer, especially edges, receives 20 seconds of heat. A full page size transfer may take 80 to 120 seconds to transfer.
- Remove transfer paper backing while warm for a satin finish or when it cools completely for a glossier finish.

NOTE: Additional time may be needed for 100% cotton fabrics, larger transfers or cooler irons, as iron temperatures can vary greatly.

LAUNDERING INSTRUCTIONS

- Wait 24 hours before washing.
- Turn garment inside out.
- Machine wash in cold water with mild detergent, **NO BLEACH.** Do not use hot water.
- Remove promptly from washer as bleeding may occur if left wet. If bleeding occurs, rewash.
- Tumble dry low or lay flat to dry. If air drying, blot excess water from image with a clean dry towel.
- Do not stretch the image as cracking may occur.
- Do not iron directly on transfer. If ironing is necessary, cover with baking parchment (available at grocery stores).

STORAGE

- Always store unused product in original package in a flat, cool, dry location.

This product is intended for use in standard ink jet printers only. Do not use in other printers or copiers such as laser printers or any other printer/copier that applies heat, as it may damage the machine. Test the product you plan to use to determine the suitability of the product for your equipment, methods and substrate material.
